We are committed to delivering the highest quality in early education and care for your child. As part of this commitment, we are proud to offer government-funded places in our settings. These places are designed to bridge socioeconomic gaps and encourage parents and carers into the workplace.

It is important to clarify that the early years funding pays for the statutory requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS), ensuring that the education and welfare needs of children are constantly met and that no child will be deprived of these essentials due to accessing a funded place. However, funding does not cover any additional aspects that childminders provide on top of these basics.

Within all our nursery settings the only additional charges are for snacks and dinners.

- Snacks - £1.00 per session
- Dinners - £3.50 per session

To offer funded childcare places, we request that parents/carers of children within our nurseries agree to pay for chargeable extras, covering aspects above and beyond what is essential to implement the basic EYFS curriculum.

This will allow us to continue to provide enriching experiences and a well-resourced curriculum for children. We follow strict guidelines when requesting such payments to ensure compliance with government regulations and any additional terms and conditions set by the local authority.

We understand that each family's financial circumstances are unique and want to reassure you that no child will be excluded from essential aspects of care or the EYFS curriculum based on whether they make these payments. In addition, parents/carers have the right to opt-out at any point.

Please be aware that should we find that we are unable to provide the exceptional curriculum experiences we pride ourselves on, due to financial constraints, then we may need to review the sustainability of accepting early years funding as a payment method.

From time to time, there may be outings the children may attend for example, trip to the Zoo, Pantomime, Farm visits etc. Your nursery will inform you of such possible trips, with the possible charges. Opting out is always an option, if you do not wish your child to attend these trips.

We sincerely appreciate you're understanding and collaboration in supporting our mission to provide the best possible early education for your child.
